

Cursillos in Christianity of the Diocese Of Monterey

Secretariat Meeting Minutes

02 April 2008

1. Opening: The regular meeting of the Cursillo in Christianity of the Diocese of Monterey Secretariat was called to order at 7:06p.m. on 02 April 2008 at the Madonna Del Sasso's Cronin Center.

2. Voting Members Present: Kelly Cadiente, Mark Kite, Cindy Stefani, Liz Tana, Karen Victorino and Cindy Vierra.

3. Secretariat opened with prayer and a meditation by Cindy Stefani.

4. Secretariat members participated in a Leaders' Group Reunion.

5. Kelly called for the approval of the agenda. Item 10 d Pastoral Plan was added. Karen then made a motion to accept the agenda. Cindy Vierra seconded the motion. Motion passed with a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.

6. A motion was made by Cindy Vierra and seconded by Karen to accept and approve the 05 December 2007, 06 February 2008 and the 05 March 2008 minutes with corrections as noted. Motion passed with a vote of 6 ayes and 0 nays.

7. Correspondence: Kelly stated she received the April National Newsletter.

8. Treasurer's Report: Copies of the treasurer's report were given out. Expenses for the month were Bulk Mail postage and Web Site renewal. Cindy Stefani made a motion to accept the report. Liz Tana seconded the motion. Motion passed with a vote of 6 ayes and 0 nays.

9. Committee Reports:

a. Pre-cursillo (Liz): No report.

b. Weekend (Cindy Stefani): Nothing to report.

c. Post-cursillo (Kelly): The next Ultreya scheduled will be held on April 8th at Saint Joseph's in Spreckels. Holy Eucharist in Corralitos will sponsor/host the May Ultreya on 10 May 2008. All Ultreyas will start at 7:00p.m. Kelly asked if the June Ultreya which is scheduled for 14 June could be moved back one week as Saint Francis Xavier is having a concert that night

by Jesse Manibusan. Mark will contact Herb Schueneman to see if there is a meeting place for 21 June.

d. School Of Leaders (Cindy Vierra): Just prior to giving her report Cindy received an emergency telephone call and had to leave the meeting. Kelly gave the following report:

1. The School did not meet in March. The School did meet prior to the Secretariat meeting today. We continue to read and study *What It Means To Be Catholic* and the *Leaders' Manual* and the current assignment schedule will be updated. It was decided the book "*The Mass Is Never Ended*" will be the next study material for the Doctrinal presentation once the School completes *What It Means To Be Catholic*.

2. Review of the Pastoral Plan changes was tabled as Cindy had the Pastoral Plan with its changes in her possession when she left.

3. We still do not have a Spiritual Leader.

e. Palanca (Mark): Mark went over the Palanca Report. Palanca was sent to Don Jozovich, the Cadiente family (Kelly, Tony and Vicki) and Sharon Metzger for members of their immediate families who had passed away.

f. Fundraising:

1. The Bakeless – Bake Sale held in February 2008 has brought in \$870. There are a few donations yet to be received from those who have stated they were going to donate.

2. The "Spaghetti" fundraiser which was to be held on Saturday 02 August at Our Lady Of Refuge's church hall had to be rescheduled due to a conflict with Spirit West Coast. Cindy did not yet have a new date.

10. Old Business:

a. Post-Cursillo chairperson vacancy still remains.

b. Obtaining Secretariat Items from previous Secretary is still pending.

c. 2008 Fall Weekends: Kelly stated there are some open weekends in the Fall at Camp Saint Francis: the 1st, 2nd and 4th weekends of September (we have the 3rd weekend already reserved); and the 2nd and 5th weekends of October. After much discussion it was decided not to seek the 5th weekend of October as that was Halloween. Karen made a motion which was seconded by Liz to seek the following weekends: 1st choice: 3rd and 4th weekend of September, 2nd choice: 3rd weekend of September and 2nd weekend in October, and the 3rd choice: 2nd and 3rd weekend in September. Motion passed with a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.

d. Review of the Pastoral Plan was tabled as noted earlier.

11. New Business:

a) Regional Coordinator Visit: Kelly stated that Regional Coordinators are tasked by National Secretary to visit the local movements. Tammy, Region 11 Coordinator will be coming to our diocese soon. Tammy stated there was a Chaplin at Fort Hunter Liggett who was inquiring about having a Cursillo weekend at the fort. Kelly stated if this were to happen Regional would have to assist us.

12. Announcements and Sharing of Information:

a) Karen stated Lew DePedro's son-in-law passed away in Atwater and Marlene Escobar's father also passed away.

b) Regional Meeting in Fresno will be held on Friday 25 April through Sunday 27 April 2008 at the Ryan Pastoral Center.
